VISION:

The Christian Counseling Center, LLC (CCC) is a non-denominational group of Christian Professionals gathered to provide Truth-Based Counseling and Support Services which will empower individuals, families and organizations to reach their full, God-given potential. We:

- Assist individuals, couples and families who are going through difficult times by providing the support they need to overcome issues from the past, find freedom from unhealthy patterns of thought and behavior, and live full and productive lives.
- Assist individuals, couples and families to look at their life's issues through God's perspective by utilizing His Word, the Bible, and the Holy Spirit, God's Gift to us through Christ, as the Counselor.

COUNSELING SERVICES:

We provide biblical counseling and services to children, adolescents, adults, couples and families. Some of the most common treatment areas are:

- General - depression, anxiety/panic, adjustment issues, emotional disorders, substance abuse, grief, job stress, spiritual issues, vocational/job search, relationship and family of origin issues;
- More Specific – rape, molestation, non-epileptic seizures, pornography and/or sexual addictions, dependency upon psychogenic medications;
- For Women - abuse and trauma recovery, eating disorders, depression, phase of life, sexuality and abortion recovery;
- For Men - anger management, sexual addiction, sexual identity issues, accountability issues;
- Relationships - marriage counseling, premarital counseling, separation, divorce recovery, infertility and sexual dysfunction;
- Parent/Child/Teen - parenting issues, behavior problems, learning disabilities, attention deficit disorders, hyperactivity disorders, trauma from abuse or loss, play therapy, eating disorders, self-injury; and,
- Family - family therapy, blended families, adoption, sibling issues.

STAFF:

Each counselor has been called to approach their profession from a Christian, Biblical perspective. In addition to their clinical, pastoral and academic training, each brings a deeply rooted faith, an acceptance of God's call to minister to His hurting people, and a prayerful response to every encounter they have with a client. In most cases, your counselor may be an individual who has personally experienced your life situation and, therefore, knows intimately the road that must be traveled to experience the Power of God through healing. However, in each situation, prayerful consideration is given to the path God chooses for a client to take to achieve such healing.

Each counselor carries their own liability insurance against malpractice.

STATEMENT OF BELIEFS:

- Every human being is created in the image of God and is therefore of inestimable value;
- Intimacy with God is the ultimate goal of human life and comes to our world through Jesus Christ by the grace of God;
- God reveals each individual's meaning and purpose for life within a loving community;
- Sin, which destroys human responsiveness toward God and unity toward others, is overcome through the working of God in Jesus Christ and through His Spirit, Who renews us in faith, hope and love;

- Human suffering can become the context for discovering new dimensions to the grace of God that transforms our lives and fills them with new meaning;
- Human beings possess an intrinsically moral nature. Obedience to God and His Word promotes mental, emotional and spiritual healing and growth;
- The Bible, in its entirety, is the absolute Word of a faithful God and is therefore a powerful source for any such mental, emotional and spiritual healing and growth; and,
- The church was established to provide a loving and accepting context for healing and growth, through the gift of fellowship among believers, to flourish.

MISSION:

To promote healing and wholeness through professional counseling, consultation and education from a balanced Christian perspective (see John 4:22-24). We are committed to bringing healing, growth, and wholeness to our clients by:

- Providing services, rooted in Biblical truth and ethics, for the Christian community and the community at large;
- Practicing love, discernment, encouragement, teaching, healing, knowledge, administration, helping, and wisdom;
- Developing and honing our spiritual gifts with the scientific knowledge and professional skills of evaluation, assessment, diagnosis, treatment planning and therapeutic intervention;
- Enjoin with faith communities to extend services to those who have very limited financial resources and significant needs for treatment;
- Collaborate with all people, regardless of age, race, sex, religion, ethnicity, or socio-economic status with respect, empathy and acceptance;
- Affirming and carefully following the Scriptural teachings of the Christian faith and the ethics of the boards that govern our profession;
- Offering seminars and resources that strengthen individuals, families, and the community; and,
- Offering continuing education for licensed biblical counselors, therapists and interns.

APPOINTMENTS: Daytime, evening, and weekend appointments are available.

An initial intake assessment can be scheduled by calling the office.

WHY WE CHARGE: CCC has been established as a 'for-profit' service agency. Each counselor has invested in their training, both fiscally and temporally. Along with their call to service, they understand God's promise that every worker is due his wages, and have offered to provide their services at a substantially reduced rate of those found in secular professional settings.

An NSF Processing Fee of \$75 shall be added to your next visit if payment is refused by your bank.

A SCHEDULE OF FEES IS ENCLOSED FOR YOUR REFERENCE. Your counselor may have additional guidelines and/or fees according to their licensure requirements. Make sure that you are clear of all fees before sessions begin.

FEES FOR SERVICE:

Initial Visit/Intake Assessment:

- \$85.00 / 1-1½ hour session

Schedule Visits With An Assigned Counselor:

- \$85.00 - \$120.00 / 1-1½ hour session

Phone session:

- \$35.00 / accumulated in 15 minute increments, and billed accordingly.

Occasionally, professionally educated interns request to complete their practicum at CCC. They are supervised within the guidelines of their graduate programs and those of their licensing organization.

Fees for Intern Therapists:

- \$35.00 / 1 hour session

FOR FAMILIES IN FINANCIAL NEED:

CCC collaborates with pastoral counselors throughout the Las Vegas Valley who may be available for a reduced rate or no fee. Any reduction in the hourly fee is done on a 'case-by-case' basis after the completion of Fee Analysis Form (based upon your income).

Standard Sliding Scale Rates (as an example based on \$85/hr) are as follows (based upon monthly income):

- \$4,000 or over: \$85.00 per session
- \$2,500 to \$3,999: \$70.00 per session
- \$2,000 to \$2,499: \$60.00 per session
- Under \$2,000: \$50.00 per session

INSURANCE:

CCC does bill insurance providers who accept pastoral counseling as an 'out-of-network' preauthorized expense. This is done as a courtesy and does not ensure that your insurance company will compensate CCC for services rendered. You are ultimately responsible for all fees incurred. A receipt for services rendered will be provided to you to present to your insurance company, should the need arise.

CANCELLATION FEE:

If a counselor misses an appointment with you without attempting to contact you one hour prior to your schedule appointment, the next session is free of charge. Client Appointments not cancelled within 24 hours prior to the scheduled time will result in a full standard charge for the session.
